

FPSE NEIGHBORHOOD NEEDS ASSESSMENT: THE PROCESS



A neighborhood needs assessment looks at what residents like about their neighborhood and what are gaps in services that still exist in the neighborhood.

A committee of community stakeholders met on a monthly basis between April - December 2016. Committee members learned about existing projects, participated in the outreach in the community, and analyzed the data that resulted from the FPSE needs survey.

PUBLIC FORUM

A public meeting for the FPSE community was held at the Adams Boys & Girls Club on July 20th, 2016. There were a approximately 15 community members in attendance. Attendees learned about the existing services and projects in the neighborhood, and shared with organizer the needs that still exist in the neighborhood.

THE NEEDS SURVEY



The FPSE needs survey asked residents to rank specific needs in the order of importance, including public infrastructure, safety & security, amenities & human services. The survey was available both online and in paper copies. Committee members conducted door-to-door to mainly south of Manchester residence since a majority of online responses came from residents north of Manchester. The committee also outreached to residents at the FPSE National Night Out event on August 2nd 2016.
